Day 1: Halifax - Charlottetown, PEI

Learn about the Mi'kmaq people at Millbrook Cultural & Heritage Centre before crossing Confederation Bridge, the world's longest continuous multi-span bridge, to Prince Edward Island. Check into your Charlottetown accommodations for a two-night stay and enjoy a theatre performance by local entertainers at the Confederation Centre of the Arts (a substitution may be necessary depending on the theatre's schedule). Meals: none

Day 2: Prince Edward Island Touring

Enjoy a free morning in Charlottetown, Canada's birthplace, or join a complimentary walking tour of the city. This afternoon, tour the North Shore of the island, driving by red cliffs, white beaches, gently sloping sand dunes and green fields as you make your way to Prince Edward Island National Park. Before returning to Charlottetown, visit Green Gables Heritage Site, the alluring inspiration of Lucy Maud Montgomery's classic Anne of Green Gables books. Experience true Maritime hospitality this evening at a lobster supper, served in a traditional hall-style. Meals: B, D

Day 3: Charlottetown, PEI - Halifax, NS

Ferry over the Northumberland Strait back to Nova Scotia. The tour ends in Halifax. You may choose to depart straight away or add on a few extra days to explore Nova Scotia further. Ask us about adding on a visit to Cape Breton Island. Meals: B
