



Ultimate Polar Bear Adventure

Prepare to be wowed! This 6 day/5 night tour gives you two full days out on the Tundra searching for polar bears along the coastline of Hudson Bay in a designated touring-permit zone of the Wildlife Management Area. Keep an eye out for Arctic Fox, Arctic Hare and Ptarmigan. You'll also have an exciting Dog Mushing Experience!

ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrive Winnipeg and overnight

Arrive to Winnipeg today and spend the night at an airport area hotel.

Meals: None

Day 2: Winnipeg - Churchill

This morning make your way to the Winnipeg airport for your flight heading north to Churchill.

On arrival to Churchill you will be met by your guide and transferred to Lazy Bear Lodge, your home for three nights. Luggage handling is included in Churchill.

Note: your tour program includes one dinner in Churchill at the Lazy Bear Cafe, on the night of your choice (Day 2, 3, 4 or 5).

Day 3, 4 & 5: Churchill

During your time in Churchill you will be escorted on a guided cultural and heritage tour of the town of Churchill. You will visit the Inuit Museum, the Parks Canada Visitor Centre, Miss Piggy, view the outside of the polar bear jail and many of the town's beautiful murals. You'll also experience dog mushing. This approximate 1-2 mile dog mushing ride will be on sleds if there is snow and on wheels if there is none. You will learn how the dogs are trained, plus hear many entertaining stories while tasting fresh bannock and local berry jam.

The main attraction will be the arctic adventures on the Arctic Crawler™ as you explore the Wildlife Management Area in search for polar bears, arctic foxes, arctic hare and many other animals that call this area home.

Day 6: Churchill - Winnipeg

Today it's time to say farewell to Churchill. After checking out of your hotel you'll be transferred to the Churchill airport for your departure back to Winnipeg.

What to Pack

What should I pack for the trip?

We recommend bringing warm and layered clothing to prepare for wind, snow, and freezing temperatures. (Even though our tour vehicles are heated, you will need to stay warm when on the viewing deck and while the windows are open.)



- Long underwear, snug but comfortable fitting outerwear and a fleece jacket or sweater. Outer clothing should consist of a windproof material with an attached hood and a warm hat.
- Ski or wind pant to help keep your torso and lower body warm. A jacket alone will not do this.
- Gloves with ample insulation and preferable an upper extension to cover your wrists (like ski gloves).
- Warm boots with thick insulation and good grip, like Sorel and Kamik, are a must!
- Spare batteries for each camera type you bring.
- Charging cords for laptops, cell phones and tablets - a portable charger pack is also a great thing to have.
- Small carry-on with your absolute necessities in case your luggage is delayed arriving to Churchill. Remember, never pack medication or valuables in your checked luggage
