ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrive in Winnipeg

Guests will arrive in Winnipeg independently and make their way to the Inn at the Forks hotel.

Depending on your arrival time you might want to visit Assiniboine Park Zoo's Churchill exhibit, with its resident polar bears and seals. Or, spend some time exploring the Forks market or the nearby Canadian Museum of Human Rights, both situated right around your hotel. There will be a welcome dinner at the Inn at the Forks this evening, hosted by your Interpretive Guide.

Day 2: Winnipeg

Today you'll visit the Manitoba Planetarium for its interactive presentation "Inuit: People of the North" program. Then enjoy a private, guided tour of the Manitoba Museum.

Day 3: Arrive in Churchill

Early morning flight to Churchill. Activities: Churchill and area tour.

Our Northern Lights and Winter Nights adventure, led by an Interpretive Guide, offers the opportunity to capture this incredible night sky phenomenon from directly on the tundra, surrounded by the beautiful northern tundra landscape and with access to the warmth and comfort of an official Tundra Buggy and the Aurora Lodge.

You will be transported by Tundra Buggy across the frozen Churchill River to the Aurora Lounge which is positioned away from the lights of town for northern lights viewing. View the northern lights from inside the warm Aurora Lounge by peering out through the panoramic windows while sipping on a warm cup of coffee, or climb onto the roof-top observation deck for an unobstructed view. Or, for the warm-blooded, climb right down onto the ground to watch and photograph the northern lights directly from the tundra.

Days 4: Churchill Town and Area Tour - Itsanitaq Museum

Experience the incredible culture and warmth of the town and people of Churchill. Today you'll enjoy a Churchill town and area tour and visit Itsanitaq Museum. Itsanitaq Museum has a collection of Inuit carvings and artifacts that are among the finest and oldest in the world dating from Pre-Dorset (1700 B.C.) through Dorset, Thule and modern Inuit times.

Days 5: Snowshoeing - Northern Lights

Head out of town today and enjoy a snowshoeing program with a local resident leading the way. Instruction will be provided to those who have never snowshoed before. This evening you'll head out onto the tundra to the Aurora Lounge for Northern Lights viewing.

Day 6: Dog sledding - Northern Lights

An always popular activity, today it's a dog sledding excursion, hosted by a local resident and dog sledding expert. This evening you'll take part in Northern Lights viewings from a Tundra Buggy.

Day 7: Parks Canada Visitor Centre - Depart for Winnipeg

Check out of your Churchill hotel before departing for the day's activity, a presentation at the Parks Canada Visitor Centre. This afternoon you fly back to Winnipeg. There will be an evening farewell dinner before saying goodbye to your fellow travellers and turning in for the night.

Day 8: Depart Winnipeg

Depart Winnipeg anytime today, or choose to extend your stay and explore the Manitoba capital.
