Day 9-19: Croatia

Arriving in Dubrovnik, visit some of the many UNESCO Cultural Heritage sites Croatia has to offer. Explore many of Croatia's ancient cities including Split, Trogir, Klis, Hvar, Zadar, Plitvice and finish off in Zagreb.
