### ITINERARY

#### Day 1: Ottawa to Cape Dorset

Fly north from Ottawa to Iqaluit, then connect onward to Cape Dorset. You will be picked up at the airport and taken to your hotel where you will check-in for a three night stay. You will have all your meals provided for you at the Dorset Suites.

#### Days 2 & 3: Cape Dorset

A community tour is included in your program on either Day 2 or 3. Other optional tours may be pre-booked for you, such as boat trips, hiking tours or visits to the community's local artists. The availability of tours is dependant on the time of year. We will provide you options at the time of your inquiry, so you can see what the tours are that you can choose from.

#### Day 4: Cape Dorset to Ottawa

Today you depart from Cape Dorset to Iqaluit and then on to Ottawa, where your tour ends.

### TOUR NOTES

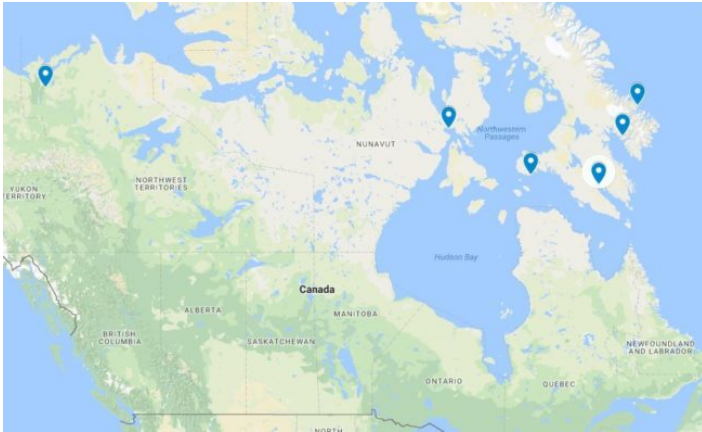
Blessed with breathtaking arctic landscapes and an amazing abundance of inspiring arctic wildlife, Dorset Island and nearby Mallikjuaq Territorial Park are great places to view, draw and photograph migratory caribou, seabirds, whales, seals and walruses.

‘Kinngait’ is a popular destination for naturalists and art lovers who come here each year to experience the Inuit culture, to enjoy the treasures of the place and chat with the local artists.

Please note, fog is a very common occurrence in Cape Dorset in the summer and early fall. It is imperative that you leave yourself a buffer at the end of your trip to allow for delays (sometimes a day or two, not just hours). Trip cancellation and interruption insurance that covers weather delays is critical.
