ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrive Iceland

Following your arrival at Keflavik Iceland, transfer by bus into Reykjavik and overnight at a guesthouse.

Day 2: Snaefellsness Peninsula

Pick up your car this morning and travel north around Snaefellsnes peninsula and the westward tip of Iceland.

Worried about finding your way around? Don't be! We'll give you the best possible driving directions, written by Icelanders (translated into English, of course!), in addition to a GPS in the rental vehicle. We also recommend you purchase an Icelandic SIM card to put in your phone, giving you a local phone number and data while travelling through the countryside.

Day 3: Akureyi area

Today you will drive east to Akureyri or to Stortjarni for a two night stay. Either location provides an ideal base from which to explore the many attractions in this part of the country.

Day 4: Akureyri area and Lake Myvatn

Visit the city of Akureyri with its fjord scenery; head out to Godafoss, "waterfall of the Gods"; to Husavik, a primary centre for whale-watching cruises, or to Lake Myvatn with its natural wonders and hot springs.

Day 5: Eastfjords

Drive east to Dettifoss, the most powerful waterfall in Europe and continue to the picturesque East Fjords where you will overnight.

Day 6: Hofn - Skaftafell National Park

Turn south and west towards Hofn. In this area you will have time to explore incredible waterfalls and Skaftafell National Park. Tonight's accommodation is in near Hofn, Vik or Skogar.

Day 7: Skaftafell - Golden Circle area

Head inland for today to the "golden circle" territory for two nights.

Day 8: Golden Circle area

Spend today exploring the wonders of this area; hot springs of Geysir. Gullfoss waterfall and Thingvellir National Park.

Day 9: Farewell to Iceland

Your final day in Iceland, visit Reykjavik in the morning for some shopping or visit the famous Blue Lagoon. Drive to Keflavik Airport in the early afternoon, return your rental vehicle and check-in for your flight home to North America.
